Learning Disabilities Association of Manitoba (LDAM) is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and is a registered charity. LDAM was incorporated in 1966 and is funded by the United of Winnipeg. We are currently recruiting individuals to serve on our Board of Directors. The Board meets 6 – 8 times a year for approximately 2 hours.
